➤ **Slide One – Title Page**

1. Include the name of the biographee.
2. Include your name (example: “A report by Mr. Sassman”).
3. Include the date of the presentation (example: “March 21, 2018”).
4. Include a picture of the biographee.
5. Include the date of birth and death of your biographee (if possible).

(Slide 1) ----- /10

➤ **Slide Two – Setting**

1. Describe in detail the setting of the story (setting includes important times and places of biographee’s life).
2. Insert a picture of the setting or settings (could be a map or picture of biographee’s home).

(Slide 2) ----- /10

➤ **Slide Three – Physical and Characteristic Traits**

1. Make 2 bullet points for physical traits – Helen Keller was both deaf and mute...
2. Make 2 bullet points for characteristic traits – Hellen Keller was curious...determined...
3. Indicate which character trait (with an *asterisk*) is most important to you and WHY
4. Picture of biographee.

(Slide 3) ----- /10

➤ **Slide Four – Text to Self**

1. Compare – List 2 similarities between you and your biographee. Be specific, give examples.
2. Contrast – List 2 differences between you and your biographee. Be specific, give examples.

(“Lebron James is tall, I am not,” is not a good example.)

(“George Lucas has a wild imagination, and I am more realistic,” is a good example)

3. Insert a picture of you and the biographee.

(Slide 4) ----- /10

➤ **Slide Five – Major Accomplishments**

1. Why is there a biography about your biographee? Include a minimum of three bullets (accomplishments)?
2. Indicate which accomplishment (with an *asterisk*), is most important to you and be prepared to speak about why.
3. Insert a picture of biographee.

➤ **Slide Six – Book Recommendation**

1. Do you give your book five stars? Two thumbs up? A Ten out of Ten? Be sure to include a satisfying explanation why.
2. Include a picture of the book you read.

(Slide 6) ----- /10

➤ **Slide Seven – Questions or Comments**

1. Include the words, “Thank You” and “Comments or Questions” on your last slide.
2. Pick an appropriate picture of your choice for the background.

1. Check your spelling.
2. Check your punctuation.
3. Check your grammar.

Presentation Skills ----- /10

1. Make eye contact with your audience.
2. Speak at an appropriate voice level.
3. Tell us...don't read from the board.
4. Use bullets to guide your presentation.

Google Slide Presentation ----- /10

1. Make sure there is a visual on EVERY PAGE.
2. There should be a total of 7 slides.
3. Transitions should be on every slide.
4. Make sure all information is present.
5. Consider your layout – is it visually pleasing (color, font, size)?
